Anaty Kokushubira is the Co-founder and Chief Operations Officer of Sebadom Enterprise, a Tanzanian dairy enterprise she helped establish in 2017 to empower small-scale farmers, especially women, through inclusive agribusiness. She is also an active member of the Tanzania Women Chamber of Commerce (TWCC) and has served as a Mentor with WEDU Global since 2023.

She earned a Certificate of Appreciation from the Tanzania Dairy Board (2021) for initiating a school feeding programme in Mbeya region, and multiple awards such as Best Food Processing Company of the Year (2023) from the Tanzania Women Industry Awards and Top Job Creator (2024) by the Graca Machel Foundation's Women Creating Wealth initiative. Anaty holds a Bachelor's Degree in Bible and Community Development from Nation to Nation Christian University and professional certifications in Power and Influence for Positive Impact (Harvard Business School) and Dream Building (Academy for Women Entrepreneurs – U.S. Embassy Tanzania).

**Sebadom Enterprise**

Is a women-led dairy processing enterprise based in Tanzania, focused on empowering small-scale farmers, improving milk quality, and ensuring access to nutritious dairy products. The enterprise works closely with over 300 farmers, including four cooperatives, and engages both direct and indirect workers across the dairy value chain. Sebadom currently employs 13 direct staff and supports 12 indirect jobs through partnerships and local sourcing. With an annual production capacity of 120,000 litres of milk, Sebadom produces and distributes high-quality dairy products while ensuring fair pricing for farmers. The enterprise also provides training to farmers—reaching 10 in the past year—and offers school feeding programmes that benefit over 3,000 students, enhancing child nutrition and local food security. Sebadom has also been recognized for its innovative and community-driven model that combines entrepreneurship with social impact, contributing to women's economic empowerment and the sustainable development of Tanzania's dairy sector.
